


AHPF Series In-Line Air Heaters

The OMEGALUX® AHPF Series In-Line Air Heaters are used to heat low flows of air, gas, water or aqueous solutions. Applications include those where clean air is necessary, as in laboratories and environmental testing areas. The stream of air is heated by passing over an enclosed heated surface rather than directly over resistance elements. This method assures that no foreign matter will enter the stream of flow. Outlet temperatures can be controlled by varying the voltage or flow rate, or by using thermocouples and time proportional temperature controllers. Consult tables below to determine maximum and minimum recommended flow rates.

Calculate the flow rate, temperature rise, or power requirement as follows:

Watts = $SCFM \times \Delta T/3$

SCFM = Standard Cubic Feet per Minute

 ΔT = Temperature Rise in Degrees F from the Inlet to the Outlet

The cold air entry should always be at the termination end of the heater. Do not run without proper air flow. Controls should be used to prevent operation of the heater without air flow, i.e. an air flow switch. Incoming air should be filtered prior to passing through the heater and be free of moisture, condensation or other contaminants.




